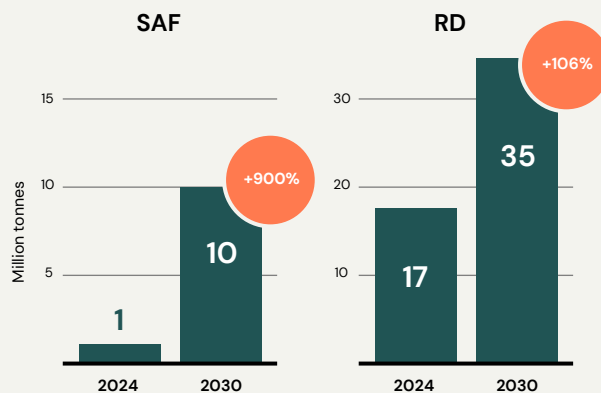

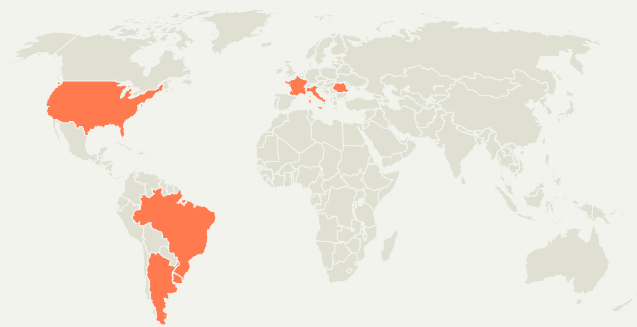
PROJECTED BIOFUELS MARKET DEMAND



Global demand for SAF is expected to grow ~900% by 2030. (From 1 million tonnes in 2024 to 10 million tonnes by 2030).

Global demand for RD is expected to grow ~106% by 2030. (From 17 million tonnes in 2024 to as much as 35 million tonnes by 2030.)
